Interior & Exterior Style Guide

Crisp white shiplap and navy accents, black-framed glazed doors that open rooms to the light, and simple painted trim — breezy, unfussy, indoor-outdoor living.

DOOR STYLES



4-Lite Frosted Door, Matte Black

Four stacked frosted lites in a slim black frame, standing open on a slate-tiled entry with timber posts and a cable stair rail — privacy without losing daylight.

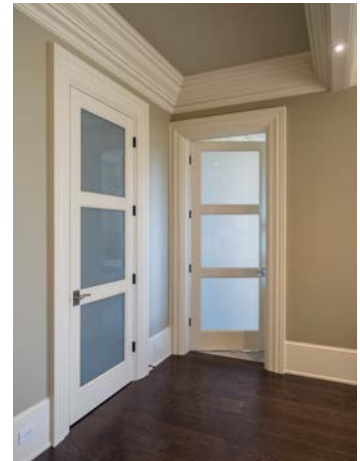
Glazing: 4-lite frosted • Frame: matte black • Hardware: brushed nickel lever



French Double Doors with Transom, Black

Divided-lite double doors under a matching transom, set into a whitewashed log wall — the easiest way to open a bedroom to a deck or view.

Glazing: 6-lite + transom • Frame: matte black • Hardware: matte black lever



3-Lite Frosted Interior Door, Painted Cream

Three frosted panes in a painted cream slab, shown on a pair of interior openings with layered crown moulding and dark oak floors — light passes between rooms, sightlines stay private.

Glazing: 3-lite frosted • Finish: painted cream • Hardware: satin nickel lever

MOOD



Bedroom, Navy Board-and-Batten

Deep navy panel moulding grounds a soft, textured headboard and warm brass accents — the one saturated colour in an otherwise pale room.



Bedroom, White Shiplap + Blue Accents

Crisp white shiplap, a gold sunburst mirror and striped indigo linens set an easy coastal tone.



Front Entry, Black Door + Sidelite

A wide-open 12-lite black door and matching frosted sidelite frame a stone-columned porch beyond.

INTERIOR SLAB & TRIM



Casing: flat 3" painted stock or a shiplap reveal — simple beach-house profiles, always painted white or cream.

Door panels: glazed lites or flat slabs; skip raised panels and heavy carving entirely.

Glazing bars: full-height 3–12 lite grids; frosted glass where privacy matters, clear where the view earns it.

Crown & base: modest 3–4" base; board-and-batten or shiplap wainscoting in place of crown in casual rooms.

Hardware: brushed nickel inside, matte black on glazed exterior and patio doors — keep one finish per elevation.

Palette: white and cream millwork, one deep navy accent wall or door, natural oak floors underfoot.

A-1 Laguna, Painted White Slab

A minimal slab with a single sweeping curved reveal — the clean interior option for coastal-modern hallways, shown on the A-1 showroom floor.
